Rationale for the Internship

Aarav had the privilege to intern with the Cosmo Foundation, the CSR wing of Cosmo First. The foundation's programs are strongly guided by the 3E principles of Education, Environment, and Empowerment. Throughout the internship, he actively participated to strengthen education initiatives of the organization. He focussed to build capacities of community-based teachers of the organization (No.75). Community-based teachers of the organization are those women and men from rural villages who have passion and basic knowledge and are trained by the organization as teachers (they are not formally trained teachers from any university). These teachers are strong educators and agents of change at grass root. Aarav studied their abilities and skills and accordingly planned programs to upgrade their knowledge and skills which intern reaches to the 12,000 rural marginalized students gaining valuable experience and contributing to the organization's mission to uplift and empower rural marginalized children and communities. He also did direct intervention with rural children which gives direct benefit to students and became a model session for rural community-based teachers.

Specific Contribution

English Communication and Fluency Development

Facilitated, guided and taught English communication and grammar to community-based teachers in the most simple, innovative and constructive manner. Adopted a participatory approach and covered several topics on the hybrid mode. English language skills, communication abilities, speaking fluency with confidence, greeting styles to external personnel and reflecting self-image through language literacy with correct pronunciation and grammatical structures appropriately was covered with though details and demonstration. It has played a crucial role in creating a supportive and interactive learning environment for rural students, enabling teachers to teach with adequate methods and acquire practical language skills that can benefit beneficiaries in various aspects of their lives.

Graphics Design & Digital Literacy

Sessions on designs and digital literacy have encouraged rural students and teachers to think creatively and develop visual communication skills. Equip them with the technical skills and knowledge to pursue careers, proficient in using the latest design software and technology, proficiency in smartphone operation, etc. to simplify the task with less time consumption. Added values and significance to teachers existing knowledge and in the digitally-driven world. It has made teachers to thrive in various professional and creative endeavours.

Women's Day Celebration

On the theme - "Breaking all Barriers", highlighted the significance of women in leadership, showcased story of women leaders like – Mala Yousafzai and set an example of – Education is power and how it can uplift individuals with knowledge, dedication, and willingness to achieve. It has empowered teachers to recognize their talents and achievements, advocate for gender equality, fosters solidarity, raise awareness, acquire more knowledge and skill. Effective Interview Skills and Strategies
